Catatan

1. **Capaian Pembelajaran Lulusan Program Studi (CPL-Prodi)** adalah rumusan kemampuan yang harus dimiliki oleh lulusan program studi yang mencakup sikap, penguasaan pengetahuan, keterampilan umum, dan keterampilan khusus sesuai dengan jenjang kualifikasi, yang diperoleh melalui proses pembelajaran.
2. **CPL-Prodi yang dibebankan pada Mata Kuliah** adalah bagian dari CPL-Prodi yang dipilih dan relevan untuk dikembangkan melalui suatu mata kuliah, sebagai dasar perumusan capaian pembelajaran mata kuliah.
3. **Capaian Pembelajaran Mata Kuliah (CPMK)** adalah kemampuan yang dirumuskan secara spesifik dan diturunkan dari CPL-Prodi yang dibebankan pada mata kuliah, serta menggambarkan kompetensi yang harus dicapai mahasiswa setelah menyelesaikan mata kuliah.
4. **Sub-CPMK** adalah kemampuan akhir yang direncanakan pada setiap tahap pembelajaran, sebagai penjabaran lebih rinci dari CPMK, bersifat terukur dan dapat diamati sesuai dengan materi pembelajaran.
5. **Indikator Penilaian** adalah pernyataan spesifik dan terukur yang digunakan untuk menilai ketercapaian Sub-CPMK, baik dari proses maupun hasil belajar mahasiswa, yang didukung dengan bukti penilaian.
6. **Kriteria Penilaian** adalah tolok ukur yang digunakan untuk menentukan tingkat ketercapaian hasil belajar mahasiswa berdasarkan indikator penilaian, guna menjamin penilaian yang objektif, konsisten, dan adil. Kriteria penilaian dapat bersifat kuantitatif dan/atau kualitatif.
7. **Bentuk Penilaian** meliputi penilaian tes dan non-tes sesuai dengan karakteristik capaian pembelajaran.
8. **Bentuk Pembelajaran** meliputi kuliah, responsi, tutorial, seminar atau bentuk lain yang setara, praktikum, praktik studio, praktik bengkel, praktik lapangan, penelitian, dan pengabdian kepada masyarakat.
9. **Metode Pembelajaran** merupakan cara penyampaian pembelajaran yang digunakan untuk mencapai capaian pembelajaran, antara lain Small Group Discussion, Project Based Learning, Case Based Learning, Collaborative Learning, Discovery Learning, Self-Directed Learning, serta metode lain yang relevan.
10. **Materi Pembelajaran** adalah bahan kajian yang disusun secara sistematis dalam bentuk pokok dan sub-pokok bahasan untuk mendukung pencapaian Sub-CPMK.
11. **Bobot Penilaian** adalah persentase kontribusi setiap komponen penilaian terhadap nilai akhir mata kuliah, yang ditetapkan secara proporsional sesuai tingkat kompleksitas dan ketercapaian Sub-CPMK, dengan total keseluruhan sebesar 100%.
12. TM = Tatap Muka, PT = Penugasan Terstruktur, BM = Belajar Mandiri.
