Program Objectives (PO) are abilities that are specifically described from the PLO assigned to a course, and are specific to the study material or learning materials for that course. 4 Subject Sub-PO (Sub-PO) is a capability that is specifically described from the PO that can be measured or observed and is the final ability that is planned at
- each learning stage, and is specific to the learning material of the course. Indicators for assessing ability in the process and student learning outcomes are specific and measurable statements that identify the ability or performance of
- student learning outcomes accompanied by evidence. **Assessment Criteria** are benchmarks used as a measure or measure of learning achievement in assessments based on predetermined indicators. Assessment 6. criteria are guidelines for assessors so that assessments are consistent and unbiased. Criteria can be quantitative or qualitative.
